

The DISCOVER northampton's Grand Finale 'northampton DISCOVERED' will take place on Monday 1st October 2012.

A one-day event at the Royal and Derngate Theatre will bring together all the elements of the campaign in an interesting, informative and visual exhibition.

Businesses will have the opportunity to exhibit in the concourse of the Theatre with zoned areas for:

- Fashion and beauty
- Eating out
- Socialising and entertainment
- Professional
- Individual and interesting

Businesses will each have a single podium to creatively display their business.

This event will be open to the public.

Later that day, an evening of fashion and beauty will take place, showcasing the best of Northampton's fashion and beauty scene, demonstrating the energy and vitality that lies within our town – now, hopefully, discovered!
