29th August 2016 – The Discover Northampton Artists Trail spotlight shines this week on the Cultural Quarter, with seven organisations hosting artwork by four talented local artists as well as their own permanent collections.

Northampton Museum and Art Gallery and **NN Contemporary Art** are two of Northampton town centre's leading cultural and creative destinations. Both are part of the Artists Trail with their own permanent exhibitions.

The Wine Connection also hosts its own permanent collection in the downstairs art gallery – pop in to explore work by Wynn Sexon. **Bang & Olufsen** is hosting artwork by Jane Warwick, while delightful fashion boutique **Voni Blu** is hosting Vicci Byles.

The historic **78 Derngate** also hosts its own permanent collection, while the **Cheyne Walk Club** plays host to artist Sara Penrose.
